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St. Nicholas House | Newport | Lincoln | LN1 3DP



St Nicholas House is a Grade II listed former Rectory.

Situated on Newport in the Cathedral City of Lincoln, it offers a contemporary style of living within an historic setting.

This luxury development offers 4 elegant Apartments and 2 individual Townhouses, all within landscaped gardens and easy walking distance of the Cathedral and Bailgate.

THE RECTORY An historic house

ituated moments from St
Nicholas Church and originally
known as The Rectory, St Nicholas House
was built in 1879 for Canon Frederick W.
Blenkin, who was rector of the Church and
Parish of Newport between 1861 and 1901.
The new rectory was designed in the Queen
Anne Revival style by the famed Lincoln
architect William Watkins, who was also
responsible for many of Lincolnshire's
well-known buildings including the
Grantham Guildhall.

St Nicholas Church itself was designed and built in 1839 by the renowned architect Sir George Gilbert Scott, who is credited with the design of St Pancras Station and the Albert Memorial in London. The stained glass windows in the South and East aisles, and many other significant additions were brought about during the forty-year term of Canon Blenkin.















CONSERVATION A sympathetic revival



w orking closely with the planning authority and building conservation experts, St Nicholas House has had its Queen Anne Revival exterior and tall brick decorated chimney stacks sensitively restored to their 19th Century splendour.

Internally, careful work has been carried out to clean and renovate original cornices, skirting's and door cases. The gardens surrounding St Nicholas House contain several mature native trees and a landscaping plan has been respectfully implemented to better compliment the setting and views.

Each Apartment and Townhouse has a unique identity and offers a different aspect over the gardens and towards the Cathedral. Many of the Apartments and Townhouses contain original features including: stained glass windows, cornicing, wooden floors and fire surrounds.

SPECIFICATION All in the detail

ach of the 4 Apartments and 2 Townhouses within St Nicholas
House have been designed to make the most of the original features and layout of the historic house. Every apartment has its own unique feel determined by a range of factors including; period features, garden views, individual front doors and private gardens. Sizes range from two bedroom Apartments offering 1,172 square feet up to three bedroom Townhouses, offering 1,320 square feet. All Apartments and Townhouses include contemporary, spacious kitchens and well-appointed bathrooms.

Two car parking spaces are included with each Apartment and Townhouse. The communal gardens will be available to all residents to use. Two of the four Apartments come with their own private garden terrace, whilst both Townhouses enjoy private gardens and car parking.











A place in time

S t Nicholas House is situated on the corner of St Johns Road and Newport, moments away from the historic Cathedral Quarter of the City

Lincoln is accessible from the A46 dual carriageway, which directly connects it with Newark (A1M) and Leicester (M1). The A15 follows the ancient Roman road both North to Hull and South to Peterborough.

Railway links are good, with Newark Northgate Station and the East Coast Mainline only 19 miles away. Also, Lincoln Central Station has a regular return train to London Kings Cross Station.
















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
